GUATEMALA

GUATEMALA TEAM
June 18th to June 25th, 2011

Once again, we will be going to Guatemala City to act as the hands and feet of Jesus Christ, and through our actions, show His love. We will be working alongside Potter's House Association, a ministry that serves the people living and working around the garbage dump in Guatemala City. Last year, members from COS installed 9 wood-burning stoves, painted two city blocks long of graffiti-filled community walls, provided Organizational Development training for the Human Resource staff as well as senior staff members, and delivered food buckets to five needy families. This year, the work we choose will depend upon the size and makeup of the group. We could construct a new house, pour cement floors, install stoves, paint walls, or build bunk beds for those families that are sleeping on dirt floors. If you're a doctor, nurse, dentist, or any other type of medical professional, we could host a medical clinic for the people in the communities. The work is rewarding as we get to work alongside those in the community and are able to share the Word with them, each and every day.
