Children's Ministry also provides age-appropriate SUNDAY MORNING OPPORTUNITIES.

Our character-training program starts in the **Nursery** where we begin our teaching ministry on your child's first day at church. Infants learn to trust those loving, smiling faces who look after them while Mom & Dad worship down the hall. Even the little ones hear leaders sing songs about Jesus and have their hearts first introduced to the love of God.

Our **Preschool** ministry teach kids (2 yrs.-K) the way they learn best. Children meet basic Bible truths through music, play times and discovery centers.

Elementary kids (Gr. 1-6) study the Bible in small groups in our Sunday School classes. Loving Sunday School teachers direct them through Bible study, discussion groups, including crafts, games, puzzles, snacks, and contests. Our sixth graders are invited to join the Sunday and Worship JAM programs uniquely planned for them and their friends.

In **Kids Church**, guys and girls learn to worship under the leadership of a committed team of men and women. Songs, skits, Bible challenges and game shows help kids remember the Bible truths and make a connection between God and everyday life.
